A motion was made to approve the Columbarium policies and pricing addendum with corrections by Joseph, seconded by Brown with all in favor.

The Pestel grant was reviewed and discussed with a decision not to apply this year.

The Board agreed to accept the retired trashcans from Main Street. Discussion was had on how to best utilize and refurbish the receptacles. This will be a great opportunity with little cost to see how well they will be utilized.

Bollards have not been placed at this time. Rhodes will check with the supplier.


Wreaths Across America will be placing wreaths on graves during the month of December and it was once again discussed that removal of the wreaths should be prior to the First of April.
