A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Valentine, Nebraska was held April 18, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Library Meeting Room, the same notice of meeting was given according to law. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the meeting was open to the public. A public information council agenda packet was available at the public information table. Notice of the Open Meetings Act was provided as required by law.

The Council and those in attendance recited the pledge of allegiance.

Council President Kyle Arganbright opened the meeting with the following Council members in attendance: Neil Wescott, Dave Otradosky, Andrew Ward and Kalli Kieborz. Also in attendance were City Manager Shane Siewert, who recorded the minutes.

Councilmember Wescott made the motion to approve the consent agenda items: #2a) Regular Library Board meeting minutes of March 25, 2019; #2 b) Economic Development Board meeting minutes of February 25, 2019; #3a) Regular City Council Meeting minutes of March 14, 2019; #4 February, 2019 Financial Reports; #5 March, 2019 Receipt Report; #6 March, 2019 Claims & Payroll. Councilmember Kieborz seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Kieborz, Wescott, Arganbright, Otradosky. Voting no: Ward. Motion carried four to one.

Councilmember Ward made a motion, seconded by Otradosky to adopt the disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) for Miller Field. Voting aye: Arganbright, Otradosky, Ward, Kieborz, Wescott, Motion carried unanimously

Councilmember Wescott made a motion, seconded by Otradosky, to approve agreement with the Valentine Livestock Auction Company to allow them to tap into the new 1st Street storm sewer. Voting aye: Wescott, Ward, Arganbright, Kieborz, Otradosky. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Otradosky made a motion, seconded by Wescott, to reappoint Luke Moser and Gregg Perrett to the airport advisory board. Voting aye: Kieborz, Wescott, Arganbright, Otradosky. Ward. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Arganbright made a motion, seconded by Wescott, to reappoint Devin Muirhead and Jeff Wragge to the Golf Course Board through March of 2022. Voting aye: Otradosky, Arganbright, Wescott, Kieborz, Ward. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business before the council, Council Chairperson Arganbright declared the meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
