A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Valentine, Nebraska was held April 9, 2020 at 7:00 p.m, via video conference at <https://www.gotomeet.me/CityofValentine>. Notice of meeting was given according to law. Council President Kyle Arganbright opened the meeting with the following Council members in attendance online: Neil Wescott, Kalli Kieborz, Andrew Ward. Also in attendance were City Manager Shane Siewert, City Attorney, Suzy Beel and City Clerk Deanna Schmit recorded the minutes.

Councilmember Arganbright made a motion to approve the consent agenda items: #2a) Regular Library Board meeting minutes of March 23, 2020; #3a) Regular City Council Meeting minutes of March 12, 2020; #4) February, 2020 Financial Reports; #5) March, 2020 Receipt Report; #6) March, 2020 Claims & Payroll. Councilmember Kieborz seconded the motion. Voting yes: Kieborz, Wescott, Arganbright. Voting no: Ward. Motion carried three to one.

Councilmember Ward made a motion, seconded by Arganbright, to adopt Resolution No. 0409201 adopting and approving the execution of an agency agreement with Nebraska Department of Transportation, Aeronautics Division for Project No. 3-31-0084-011 (R02). Voting yes: Kieborz, Wescott, Arganbright. Ward. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Wescott made a motion, seconded by Arganbright, to approve the Valentine Fire Department request for \$95,692.00 for down payment on 2020 Freightliner pumper truck. Voting yes: Wescott, Arganbright, Ward, Kieborz. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business before the council, Council Chairperson Arganbright declared the meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m..
